This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 08.04.2017 in case FIR No.34 dated 08.04.2017, under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

[2]. The petitioner is a woman and there is no record of her involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act. The contraband allegedly recovered in this case was marginally above the commercial quantity.

[3]. At this stage, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, she is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
