This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.296 dated 12.09.2018, registered under Sections 354, 294, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of POCSO Act at Police Station Division No.7, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Even before the arguments having been addressed on the merits of the case, learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the matter is still under investigation and it pertains to offences committed upon two minor children.
