In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.209, dated 25.08.2017, under Sections 452, 427, 506, 436, 511, 34 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for more than five months now, since 15.09.2017.
3. Investigation in the meantime has already been completed and challan is submitted.
4. The other co-accused persons are already on bail.

5. Consequently, the petitioner's further indefinite detention at this stage is not justified.

6. In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Gurmukh Singh son of Bahal Singh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
