The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for conducting inquiry into the FIR No. 561 dated 14.06.2018 under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

On instructions from SI Vishavjit Singh, learned State counsel has stated that after investigation the cancellation report has been prepared and is likely to be submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction very shortly.

In view of the above learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant petition and consequently the

same is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
