This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 147, 148, 149, 188, 120-B IPC and 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Mani Majra, Chandigarh, vide FIR No.206 dated 25.08.2017.

Petitioner is stated to be incarcerated since 25.8.2017. Prosecution claims that certain recoveries have been effected from him. Admittedly, investigation has been completed and challan submitted before the competent court. Trial is in progress. Same may take some time to conclude.

In view of above, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
