Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioner at the behest of respondents No.4 to 12 or anybody else.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after having been acquitted in FIR No.69 dated 22.06.2016 registered under Sections 363, 366(A), 376, 323, 506 of IPC and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act 2012 at Police Station Titram, Kaithal, respondent No.4 and other family members are extending threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, and for this, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 06.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal i.e. respondent No.2.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna,

Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these

respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case and confining the prayer of the petitioner for protection of his life and liberty, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to consider the prayer of the petitioner for the limited purpose of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and to act in accordance with law.
