SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.318, dated 08.08.2018, under Sections 306, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 08.08.2018. The investigation is complete, but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 05 PWs have been examined out of 21 PWs. There are no other criminal cases pending against him and thus, he may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

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Keeping in view the fact that the investigation is complete as well as the fact that there are no other cases under the NDPS Act, 1985, pending against the petitioner, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody indefinitely. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as large number of prosecution witnesses remain to be examined. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, at Yamuna Nagar.
