By way of present application, applicant seeks impleadment of Harpreet Singh son of Kulvir Singh, resident of Dhani Inakhera, Tehsil Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib as respondent No. 3-owner of the truck which was damaged. No ground to implead the said Harpreet Singh-truck owner as party respondent is made out. However, he is at liberty to seek compensation with regard to damage of his truck from the accused-petitioner.

Application stands disposed of.

CRM-M-47485-2017

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.104 dated 30.09.2017 under Sections 382, 511, 341, 427, 323, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1) with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

As per report received from Learned Sub Division Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha, compromise have been effected between the parties, which is without any pressure and coercion so that they will live in peace and harmony to avoid any future enmity. Perusal of the FIR shows that allegations are of stopping the vehicle of the complainant, beating him and trying to snatch the vehicle.

In the circumstances that both the parties have amicably settled the dispute. Therefore, FIR No.104 dated 30.09.2017 under Sections 382, 511, 341, 427, 323, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1) with consequential proceedings qua petitioner, stands quashed qua the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed.
