Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.56, dated 15.05.2017, under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Nawanshahar, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is of 100 grams of alprazolam.

The recovery stated to have been effected would be construed as border line as quantity in excess of 100 grams of alprazolam would be construed as commercial quantity.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan has been presented.

Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merit, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Trial Court /Duty Magistrate concerned.
