The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.37 dated 13.05.2016, registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural) under Sections 3 and 6 of East Punjab Control of Bricks Supplies Act, 1949.

Pursuant to order dated 14.12.2017, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court and to get their statements recorded.

Report dated 07.02.2018, has been received, according to which, the complainant, Balraj Singh, DFSC Ferozepur, had no knowledge whether the department wanted to get the present FIR quashed or not.

Learned counsel for the petitioner draws the attention of this Court to memo dated 29.08.2016 (Annexure P13), wherein it has been stated that the licence of M/s National BKO, Village Burj Hakima, was being renewed and that fee upto 2019 had already been deposited and thus, a recommendation has been made for cancellation of the FIR.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the issuance of the aforementioned memo dated 29.08.2016 (Annexure P13).

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.37 dated 13.05.2016, registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural) under Sections 3 and 6 of East Punjab Control of Bricks Supplies Act, 1949 alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
