Present petition has been filed with the prayer to direct the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their staff members and students.

Perusal of the affidavit of Ravinder Kumar PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter-cum-Sub Division Patti, reveals that the college complex is merely nearby the police station and routine patrolling are going on regularly and there is no need to provide any security to the petitioners. To make the things more clear, para 3 and 4 of the affidavit are extracted hereunder:-

“3.That the college complex is nearby the police station and routine patrolling are going on regularly. However, if any complaint has been come into the notice to the concerned

police station or higher officials the legal action can be taken accordingly.

4. That as per circumstances explained above there is no need to give security to the petitioner and if it can be used as status symbol and for other means. (copy of the conclusion report of inquiry dated 12.11.2018).

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners is fully satisfied and consequently, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous. However, it is made clear that the State of Punjab shall be bound by the assertions made in the affidavit and in case of any breach, the law will take its own course.

Disposed off accordingly.
