1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

KULDIP SINGH J. (Oral)

Learned State counsel has filed list of ten cases, registered against the petitioner. He has been acquitted in one of the cases and nine cases are still pending against him before various Courts in Gurguram Sessions Division.

In this case, it is alleged that fake identify of one Ravi Kumar was used by somebody, to identify the surety in the bail bonds, which are furnished for bailing out the present petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 4.8.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at that time, petitioner was in custody. Therefore, he cannot be blamed for some impostor appeared as identifier. All these matters are to be examined during trial. All the offences are triable by the Magistrate. In this case, challan has

already been presented and charges have been framed. Conclusion of trial will take time. Therefore, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any purpose.

Accordingly, the application is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, subject to following conditions:-

- (i)The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer,
- (ii)The petitioner will surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any and shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iii)He will appear before trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
