On 14.12.2017, following order was passed:-

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 663 dated 28.09.2017, under Sections 3/13(1), 8/13(3) 17 of Haryana Gauvansh Sarankashan and Gau Samvardhan Act, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR, which has been registered on the basis of secret information, are that a motorcycle rider was signaled to stop but on seeing the police party, he ran away after leaving the motorcycle with the cow flesh. Learned counsel further contends that the motorcycle does not belong to the petitioner, who is 70 years old and is suffering from Tuberculosis. He also contends that he shall be placing on record the document pertaining to the medical condition of the petitioner.

Issue notice to respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Arjun Singh Yadav, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Let, a complete copy of paper book be supplied to him, during the course of the day.

List on 23.01.2018.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.

In the event of his arrest, the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioner on ad-interim bail subject to his/her satisfaction. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh stated that petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated 14.12.2017 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
