Heard. In this case, one Ajay Chauhan alias Pappu was arrested alongwith 250 tablets of Tramadol. A case under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, was registered. During interrogation, he disclosed that he purchased said drugs from petitioner.

The learned State counsel was directed on last date of hearing to verify as to what evidence has been collected against supplier.

Today, the learned State counsel states that it has come in inquiry that petitioner is a supplier of drugs to various persons. Therefore, his interrogation is required to find out as to how many people, he has been supplying drugs illegally. Therefore, his custodial interrogation is necessary. State counsel has further informed this Court that petitioner has already been arrested by police in another case under NDPS Act, 1985.

Since police has come to conclusion that custodial interrogation of petitioner is necessary to find out source of drug supply and also that he has been arrested by police in another case of similar nature, no ground to grant anticipatory bail to petitioner is made out. Petition is dismissed.
