Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.117, dated 13.06.2011 under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana City.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Pal Singh informs the Court that the petitioner, having been granted concession of bail, misused the concession on two separate occasions and was declared a proclaimed offender twice over.

Petitioner has now been arrested and is in custody since 12.08.2017.

Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, the concession of regular bail is declined at this stage.
