This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.16 dated 03.02.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna (District Police), District Khanna, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 13.12.2017, report dated 01.02.2018, has been received from Ms. Radhika Puri, Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khanna, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4 accepts the factum of compromise (Annexure P-2) and states that the

compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.16 dated 03.02.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna (District Police), District Khanna, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed.
