This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar, vide FIR No.142 dated 21.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.1 has surrendered before the investigating agency. Petitioner No.2 has already joined investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel (on the instructions from ASI Baldev Raj, who is present in court) does not controvert the aforesaid contention.

In view of above, the interim order dated February 09, 2018 is hereby made absolute in respect of petitioner No.2, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
