The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.233 dated 24th November, 2017, registered under Sections 379-B, 411 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

The petitioner was arrested from the spot itself after he had allegedly stolen a polythene bag from the wife of the complainant.

Investigation against the petitioner has still not been completed.

Considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner namely Davinder Singh at this stage, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned subject to the further condition that he shall report at the concerned Police Station once a week till completion of investigation.
