The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.172 dated 28.04.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, Gurugram.

Heard.

It has been submitted that petitioner was arrested in criminal case and surety was given by someone but surety paper found to be fake and false.

Petitioner is in custody since 10.08.2018. Final police report has been submitted.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial court / Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate with a

condition that he will not give any security or surety before any court of law till disposal of the trial and subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
