Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Binder Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation in this case and further states that recovery of revolver has already been effected from him. It is further pointed that no fire was shot from the alleged revolver and it was used from its reverse side.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the petition for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that a specific role has been attributed to the petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Heard.

Since the recovery of the alleged weapon is already there and the petitioner has joined investigation in pursuance of order dated

8.1.2018 and his custodial interrogation is not required by the police.

In the light of above circumstances, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 8.1.2018 is made absolute subject to conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
