AVNEESH JHINGAN, J.

This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been moved by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 215 dated 8.11.2017, under Sections 308, 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Lalru District SAS Nagar Mohali, Punjab.

This Court, on 14.12.2017, passed the following order:

“In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of her arrest being required, she shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which she shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to her.”

Learned States counsel, on instructions from ASI Sulakhan Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the statement of the learned State counsel, the order dated 14.12.2017 is made absolute. The petitioner to file regular bail bonds before the learned trial Court on presentation of challan.

The petition is allowed.
