LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 1044 dated 23.11.2017 under Section 304B/34 IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, Panipat.

The petitioners are the parents-in-law of the deceased. It is submitted that they have falsely implicated, in this case, without there being any specific allegations against them. Allegations, if any, are against their son.

Heard, learned counsel for the parties.

It is not in dispute that death of the petitioners' daughter-in-law took place within one year of her marriage with their son. All of them were lived together in the matrimonial home. It is stated by the complainant (father of the deceased) that after some days of the marriage, his daughter was harassed by all the accused persons. The complainant side fulfilled their demands several times but the accused continuously harassed his daughter.

Death of the complainant's daughter is stated to be due to hanging.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any ground to afford the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

It is reiterated that none of the observations made herein above are a reflection on the merits of the case and are solely confined for the purpose of the decision of this petition.
