Prayer in this petition is for directing the respondents to stop initiating the multiple inquiries in FIR No. 65 dated 05.06.2017, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 341, 506 and 34 of the IPC, registered on the statement of the petitioner and in DDR No. 29 dated 05.06.2017, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered on the statement of Malkit Singh, respondent No. 9.

Reply, by way of an affidavit of DSP (Rural), Ferozepur, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per reply, after registration of the FIR No. 65, inquiry was conducted by Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Ferozepur and it was found that the facts mentioned in the same are similar to the investigation conducted by the Investigating Officer SI Sat Pal, SHO, Kulgarhi. It is further stated that another application was moved by one Sukhjinder Singh before the Inspector

General of Police, Bathinda Zone, Bathinda and in the inquiry, conducted by Superintendent of Police (H), Ferozepur, he had accepted the first inquiry report as noticed above and as on today, no further inquiry is pending. Regarding DDR No. 29, it is stated that during the course of investigation, the same was found to be false and a cancellation report has been forwarded.

In view of the position explained above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be rendered infructuous at this stage.

Dismissed as infructuous, accordingly.
