Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.43 dated 28.01.2018, under Sections 332, 323, 353, 427, 379-B, 506 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mohindergarh.

The case of the prosecution is that on 27.01.2018 at about 10:00/10:30 PM, complainant-Head Constable Ravinder Kumar, who was on duty, asked the petitioner not to drink liquor in a public place. Thereafter, petitioner hit his Bolero vehicle into the Swift Car of the complainant with an intention to kill him and also damaged his vehicle. It is also alleged that petitioner gave beatings to the complainant; manhandled him; torn off his uniform and snatched his gold chain.

Learned State Counsel has produced the Custody Certificate of petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied to opposite side.

The aforesaid Custody Certificate shows that petitioner is facing numerous cases i.e. more than 20, therefore, no case is made out to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial if there is no legal impediment.
