Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents specially to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondent No.6.

The complaint, filed by the petitioner, before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon (Annexure P-1) transpires that the petitioner took a loan of Rs.30,000/- from the private respondent No.6 Beant Singh in the year 2014. He has stated in the said complaint that he had paid the said loan in the year 2015 alongwith interest but he is unable to produce any receipt. He claims that his signatures were obtained on some blank papers and those were not returned to him.

The matter is purely of civil nature and the petitioner can seek the appropriate remedy before the forum.

In view of aforesaid, no ground is made out.

Accorrdingly the instant petition stands dismissed. However,

it is made clear that in case the petitioner is required to be arrested he be
given three days prior notice.
