The allegations of the petitioners are that the private respondents i.e. daughter in law and her family members are harassing the petitioners and are attempting to coerce them to transfer their property in favour of the private respondents. Despite representation (Annexure P1), no action has been taken thereupon by the police, till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 8, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Meanwhile, it shall be ensured that no physical harm is caused to the petitioners.
