The petitioner has filed this petition seeking issuance of direction to learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bahadurgarh for closing the case i.e. FIR No.548/13 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 as the FIR had already been quashed.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioners had filed the petition for quashing of FIR in this Court on the basis of compromise which was accepted on 09.07.2018. It has been submitted that although a copy of order dated 09.07.2018 had been furnished to the trial Court intimating about order dated 09.07.2018 passed by this Court i.e. regarding quashing of the FIR but despite the same, the trial Court vide order dated 21.07.2018 did

not drop the proceedings and further adjourned the matter to await orders from this Court.

It has however been informed today that subsequently, the trial Court has dropped the proceedings on 20.11.2018. I find that the trial Court could have very conveniently got the matter pertaining to passing of order dated 09.07.2018 verified from website of this Court and there was no need to adjourn the matter on 21.7.2018 and to unnecessarily prolong the proceedings of the case when infact the FIR in question already stood quashed. The District & Sessions Judge, Jhajjar is requested to advise the Officer in this regard.

The matter stands disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
