Mr. Gurdeepinder Singh Dhilon, Advocate has filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. The same is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.73 dated 02.05.2015 registered under Sections 307, 120-B, 148, 149 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 25.08.2017 and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

The factum of compromise has been admitted by learned counsel for the complainant.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.
