Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.75, dated 12.04.2017, under Section 18/61 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is of 19 kilograms of opium.

During the course of hearing, counsel for the petitioner has raised a number of submissions to assert that it is a case of false implication. These are contentions which would be considered by the trial Court.

In the light of alleged heavy commercial quantity having been effected, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
