By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty as she apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7. Another prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to decide her representation dated 6.10.2018 (Annexure P-3).

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is legally wedded wife of Suresh Kumar and that they were also blessed with children. It has been submitted that subsequently one Usha, claiming to have married Suresh Kumar, approached this Court alongwith Suresh Kumar seeking protection to their life and liberty, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 28.8.2018 directing the official respondents to look into their representation and that subsequently an application was filed by father of Usha, wherein it was pointed out that Suresh Kumar was already married whereupon this Court vide order dated 28.8.2018 had disposed of the application, while clarifying that the directions issued by this Court earlier, would not confer any immunity upon

the petitioners in case it is found that they have to be proceeded against in respect of any civil or criminal liability.

The learned counsel has further submitted that pursuant to passing of the aforesaid order, respondents No.4 to 7, who are parents and relatives of Usha, are threatening the petitioner and her children to move out of the village and although she had submitted an representation dated 6.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) but no effective step has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 6.10.2018 (Annexure P-3), moved by petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. In case it is found that there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner or to other members of her family, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioner or to other members of her family.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 6.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal so as to enable him to do the needful.
