The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.293 dated 13.12.2015, under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chherretta, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners herein have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the trial court and pursuant to the order dated 16.12.2017 passed by this court, they have appeared before the trial court and furnished the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court and produced on record certificate copy of the order dated 19.01.2018 passed by the trial court in this regard.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigation

Officer, does not dispute this fact.

In view of the facts that pursuant to the directions given by this court, the petitioners have appeared before the trial court and furnished the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 16.12.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
