Present 2nd petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 12.04.2018 under Sections 379-B, 411, 201 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gate Hakeeman, District Amritsar.

The allegations against the petitioner are of snatching of one mobile phone. Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that there is no other case of similar nature against the present petitioner. Moreso, co-accused Gurchet Singh has already been released on bail by this Court vide order dated 16.08.2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Arjun Kumar, has also contended that co-accused has been released on bail by this Court and there is no other case against the petitioner for committing similar offence.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 13.04.2018 and trial of the case still have to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
