This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.224 dated 16.09.2017, under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 180 bottles of liquor, Theka Desi Haryana was effected during the course of 'Nakabandi' and from one Zen Car bearing registration No.DL-3CT-4928.

Insofar as the present petitioners are concerned, they are stated to have run away from the spot.

State counsel upon instructions from HC Gurcharan Singh, Police Station Lambi, Sri Muktsar Sahib apprises the Court that the petitioners have since joined investigation.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 15.12.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.
