The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.583 dated 27.11.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 21-B, 21-C, 27-A, 61, 85 of Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Heard.

It is the case of the prosecution that recovery of contraband was effected from one Sanjay. After his arrest, he disclosed that this contraband was arranged by the present petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Dalbir Singh states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and nothing has to be recovered from him.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 14.12.2017 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
