Petitioner-Dharambir @ Bablu has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.308 dated 05.12.2016, registered at Police Station Bawani Khera, District Bhiwani, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 216 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that neither the petitioner is named in the FIR, nor any role is attributed to him.

Even during the course of arguments, learned State counsel submits that no injury is attributed to the present petitioner.

The petitioner was taken in custody on 14.01.2017 and was granted interim regular bail on 12.03.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes. Trial of the case will take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and order dated 12.03.2018, granting interim regular bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
