Prayer in this second petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.16 dated 31.01.2018 registered under Sections 307/323/341/427/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

On 08.08.2018, the following order has been passed by this Court in CRM-M No.32149 of 2018, while disposing of the first anticipatory bail application of the petitioner:-

“After arguing for some time, finding that the Court is not convinced, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

The trial Court is directed to decide the application for regular bail, to be filed by the petitioner, expeditiously.”

Counsel for the petitioner has again raised all the available pleas, which are available to the petitioner at the time of filing of the

first anticipatory bail application and the said petition was heard and dismissed as withdrawn on 08.08.2018.

Accordingly, no ground for interference is made out.
