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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)**

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.258 dated 23.5.2015 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, District Panipat as well as summoning order dated 4.1.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Panipat and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 15.12.2017, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Panipat has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of the parties have been recorded qua the factum of compromise, wherein they have stated that they have entered into a compromise and settled the matter amongst

themselves amicably. It has specifically been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.258 dated 23.5.2015 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, District Panipat and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners. Consequently, summoning order dated 4.1.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Panipat is set aside.
