This is a petition for anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 02.05.2017 under Sections 302, 307, 506, 336, 148 & 149 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

[2]. It transpires that the petitioners were declared Proclaimed Offenders vide the order passed by the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur on 14.12.2017, after the coercive process for proclamation had been ordered to be issued a month earlier on 14.11.2017.

[3]. It is pointed out on behalf of the complainant's side that the aforesaid order declaring the petitioners as Proclaimed Offenders has already been stayed by this Court on 16.01.2017 in CRM-M-959-2018 with liberty to the present petitioners to surrender before the Court of Ld. Magistrate below, and to apply for bail which is to be decided

independently on merits.

[4]. In this view of the matter at this stage, clearly the present petition for anticipatory bail becomes redundant and is, therefore, dismissed as withdrawn on submission of Ld. Counsel for the petitioners.
