HARI PAL VERMA, J.(ORAL)

This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.PC seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.139 dtd 10.07.2016 under Sections 406, 417, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 469, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Chherretta, District Amritsar.

The earlier petition filed by the petitioner i.e. CRM-M-22327 of 2017 titled as Harsh Kumari Versus State of Punjab was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 09.08.2017.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition. However, he states that in case the petitioner files an application seeking regular bail before the trial Court, the trial Court may be directed to decide the same at the earliest.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
