By this petition, quashing of FIR No. 13 dated 23.01.2015 is sought, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Nurpurbedi, District Roopnagar, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 447 IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondents no. 2 and 3 (complainants).

Vide an order of this Court dated 15.12.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sri Anandpur Sahib, has been sent to this Court, in which it is stated that Baldev Singh and Jatinder Singh, i.e. respondents no. 2 and 3, and the accused-petitioners, have suffered statements to the effect that the matter has been

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compromised without any fear or pressure on either of them, with copies of the statements having been annexed with the report. A perusal thereof shows that respondents no. 2 and 3, who are the complaints in the FIR Annexure P-1, do not wish to pursue the criminal proceedings against the petitioners.

In view of the above, in the opinion of this Court it would be pointless to continue with criminal proceedings, the parties having fully compromised the matter of their own free will.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 13, dated 23.01.2015, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Nurpurbedi, District Roopnagar, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 447 IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
