Regular bail was declined to the petitioner vide order dated 09.05.2017 on the premise that the petitioner was a Proclaimed Offender for about 11 years.

He was arrested in FIR No.08 dated 17.01.2014 under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act. On the basis of disclosure statement made therein, he was produced on production warrants and was arrested in the present case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Sham Singh submits that out of 17 prosecution witnesses, 16 witnesses have already been examined and 22.11.2018 is the date fixed for remaining evidence.

In view of aforesaid subsequent development, I see no justification to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

Dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to make every sincere endeavor to decide the case finally preferably within a period of three months from the next date of hearing fixed before it.
