Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any ground for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

The petition, as such, is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for grant of regular bail. In case, the petitioner choses to surrender before the trial Court within 2 weeks from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within 2 days from filing of such application, while also bearing in mind that the co-accused has since been acquitted vide judgment dated 3.2.2017 (Annexure P-2).
