Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.56 dated 23.07.2013 under Sections 326, 323, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur on the basis of compromise between the petitioner and respondent No.2.

Prayer has also been made for quashing of the order dated 09.08.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala vide which the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that the matter was compromised by the petitioner with respondent No.2, the FIR in question has already been quashed on the basis of compromise qua the other co-accused and it is the petitioner, who was declared as a proclaimed person by the trial Court, he could not join the proceedings for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise. Now, the petitioner is ready to surrender

before the trial Court and to face the trial or to seek quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 15 days from today, he shall be admitted on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, however, subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- by the petitioner to the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.
