By this petition, FIR No.369 dated 29.11.2017, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Central, Sector 17, Chandigarh, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 380 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later), is sought to be quashed, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner (accused) and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant. A copy of the deed of compromise has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order dated 14.02.2018, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, has been received, to the effect that the statements of the petitioner-accused, Sandeep Jindal, and

to the effect that the complainant has compromised the matter with the petitioner and that he has no grievance remaining against him, and does not object to even the quashing of the FIR itself.

As per the assessment of the learned Magistrate, the compromise effected between the parties is without any fear or undue influence.

That being so and the offence stated to be the theft of a mobile phone of the complainant, the petition is allowed and FIR No.369 dated 29.11.2017, registered at Police Station Central, Sector 17, Chandigarh, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 380 IPC (with Section 411 IPC added later), along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
