The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 15.08.2017, registered under Sections 323, 328, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Yamunanagar, District Yamunanagar.

As per the allegations, co-accused Manisha had administered intoxicating substances in the food of complainant and his family members as she had extra marital affairs with the petitioner. It has been further no direct role has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 17.04.2017.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Dharminder is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty

Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
