Upon notice having been issued on 15.01.2018 in CRM-M-48080-2017, returnable today, learned State counsel on instructions submits that the crop sown by the Gram Panchayat was paddy, in the months of June-July 2017, which the petitioner and his co-accused are stated to have harvested in October, 2017.

As already noticed vide the order of this Court dated 15.01.2018, the eviction order against the petitioner and his co-accused having been passed only in August 2017 by the Collector, prima-facie at least it would appear that the Gram Panchayat could not have sown the crop in June and July 2017.

In view of what has been observed by this Court, the petitioners in these two petitions, upon joining investigation, shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer / Illaqa Magistrate.
