The petitioner has filed this petition because she fears for her life and liberty as her parents are allegedly forcing her to live with with her husband who ill treats her. Although representation dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted but the police has failed to take any action against him.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. S.P. Singh, learned AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of order being passed, no need to issue notice to respondents No.4 and 5.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action thereupon, in accordance with law, in case find

necessary, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, it shall be ensured that the life and liberty of the petitioner is protected.
