The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.222, dated 03.08.2013, registered under Sections 188, 447, 448, 511, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Udyog Vihar, District Gurgaon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Brijesh Sharma, AAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State. Complete copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

The petitioner has been facing trial for the last about four years but the trial has not been concluded. However, he could not attend the hearing of the trial Court on 04.06.2017, as such, his bail order were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him. He moved an application for grant of anticipatory bail before the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Gurgram on 04.10.2017 but the same was declined vide order dated 23.10.2017. The trial is going on.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the

petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within seven days and on doing so, he shall be released on bail, subject to the conditions imposed by the learend trial Court and also subject to its satisfaction.
