This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.207 dated 18.09.2018, under Sections 376, 506 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division 1 Ludhaina, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana on the basis that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that both the parties were major and get into this relationship willingly and on account of a misunderstanding that arose between them, that the instant FIR has been registered. It is also contended that the matter is still under investigation and the challan has not been presented so far.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Ms. Rajni Gupta,

Senior DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Mr. Nirbhay Singh Gill, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and files the power of attorney, which is taken on record and submits that the matter has been compromised and the affidavit is available on the record showing that the relationship was consensual in nature. Copies of the petition be supplied to them during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the matter is still under investigation, the parties are directed to appear before the Investigation Officer on 13.11.2018, who will look into the contentions as raised.

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
