The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.31 dated 15.2.2018, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not an accused in any other case under NDPS Act, 1985. The investigation is complete and the challan stands presented, but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 02 PWs have been examined till date out of total 13 PWs. Even the evidence of the said PWs is not complete, thus, the petitioner is entitled to be released on regular bail.

The aforementioned factual submissions are not controverted by the learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner-Vicky Sharma, is ordered to be released on bail on

his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
